

ACCOUNT-SPECIFIC DISCLOSURES

The following additional disclosures apply to the Volt Teen Banking & Volt Banking accounts:

VOLT BANKING SAVINGS

Requirements – The Volt Banking Savings Account is for members ages 9 – 24. Members 9-17 will need to have a parent as a joint owner of the account. Once you are 18 you no longer need to have a joint account. At age 25, the account may convert to a primary savings account. Minimum daily balance requirements to receive annual percentage yield will apply.

VOLT CHECKING

Requirements – The Volt Banking Savings Account is for members ages 9-24. Members 9-17 will need to have a parent as a joint owner of the account. Once you are 18 you no longer need to have a joint account. At age 25, the account may convert to a free checking account. There is no minimum deposit requirement on this account.
